

A Guide to Verifying Your Identity

for benefit payments under \$200

In order for your benefit to be paid, we need to verify your identity. You can do this by including a **clear photocopy** of one (or more) of the documents (see options A and B below) that prove your identification. The name shown must be an exact match for:

1. The name shown on your AUSfund member account
2. The name of the bank account into which you are nominating for the funds to be credited

A – One of the following documents:

- A photocopy of your current Driver Licence showing a clear and legible photograph, your current address and signature

OR

- A photocopy of your current Passport showing a clear and legible photograph and signature

OR

B – Two documents required:

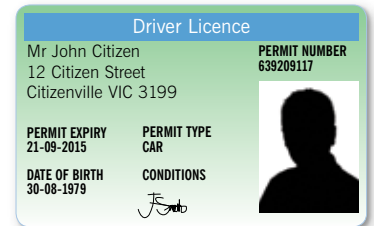
A clear photocopy of **ONE** of the following documents:

- Birth Certificate or Birth Extract
- Citizenship Certificate issued by the Commonwealth of Australia
- Your current Pension Card issued by Centrelink that entitles you to financial benefits, and shows your current address as held on your AUSfund account

PLUS one of the following documents:

- A current letter from Centrelink regarding a Government Assistance Payment that shows your **current address** as held on your AUSfund account
- Notice issued by Commonwealth, State or Local Government within the past 12 months that shows your current address. For example: A Notice of Assessment from the Australian Tax Office or a Rates Notice from Local Council

What if my name has recently changed or I am signing on behalf of another person?

You'll need to prove your name change or the link between you and the other person. You can use one of the documents below as well as your other ID (such as a Driver Licence or Passport).

Change of name

You need to provide a **certified*** copy of one of the following documents:

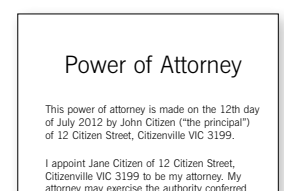
- Marriage Certificate
- Deed Poll or Change of Name Certificate from the Registry of Births, Deaths and Marriages in your state
